Title 5, Chapter 2, Section 201, et. Seq., where applicable.

Each firm shall submit three (3) bound and sealed, one original and two copies of their Qualification Statements. Telefaxed copies will not be accepted. RFQ's received after the designated time and date will be returned unopened. Failing to provide statements or documents required by the Request for Qualifications will be rejected as non-responsive.

The Division of Economic Development reserves the right to reject any and all RFQ's and to waive any informality whenever such rejection or waiver is deemed in the best interest of the Navajo Nation.
